MEETING OF FEBRUARY 13, 2023

The minutes of the January 23, 2023 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smick and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Community member Melissa Edminster reported to the council that a PTO has been formed. They are hoping to gain community support.

Business owner Mark Howard expressed concerns about the property next to Heritage Hardware. The council informed him this was in the works for the Fire Station and that another business would not be moving in.

Council signed Resolution 462X Cost of living increases for employees.

Fire Dist. 2 gave the town a quote for turn-out gear. Fire Dist. is asking for 1/3 cost of the quote. The motion to pay the requested 1/3 was given by Hinds and seconded by Hamshar.

The Mayor had a meeting with Karen Willson in regard to the Sunset addition. She has decided not to make the cul-de-sac a through street. The Mayor will contact Daniel and Tim in regards to utilizing Lot 7 for snow removal, access, etc.

Council was informed that it was possible for 204 E Oak to be going on the market. Due to the outstanding balance on the utilities a motion to put a lien on the property was given by Smick and seconded by Smith. The Clerk will do research on the necessary steps to proceed with the lien.

Public Works Steven Engles Has the opportunity to gain pesticide credits at no cost on February 21, 2023. The class is from 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM. The council agreed this was a good opportunity.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 6:57 PM.
