**MEETING OF FEBRUARY 27, 2023**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hinds, and Smick, and the Town clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the February 13, 2023 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Smick. Motion carried by a vote of the Council.

The Council discussed Spring Clean-Up, April 7-15. It was decided that the Town would once again order one garbage and one metal bin for one weekend only, April 8 & 9.

The Clerk initiated a conversation about the Utility Lien for 204 E Oak. This lean will be eligible to file March 13.

The guard rail at the bridge on Park and Broadway was damaged in an accident over the weekend. The responsible party will discuss with insurance and the Town to make arrangements to get the guardrail repaired. Public Works will also contact the County for repairs.

Fisher Roofing was able to give a bid for repairs on the shop roof. To repair both upper and lower roof areas the cost will be \$41,711 plus WSST. The Lower roof only the estimate is \$21,685 plus WSST. The Clerk will try to get other bids through the Small Works Roster.

Discussion on 106 S Margin ensued. Resident had until March 1 to clean up. No noticeable progress has been made and the Council agreed to continue with the legal abatement and the Clerk will notify the Town attorney to continue.

Additional conversations with Tim and Daniel Willson are needed for the Sunset addition. The Mayor is trying to get another meeting set up.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 6:53 PM.
