**MEETING OF MARCH 14, 2022**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hamshar, Hinds, and Smith, Public Works Chris Canaday, community members Gerald & Betty Jessen, and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the February 28, 2022 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Hinds and seconded by Hamshar. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

Mr. & Mrs. Jessen asked the council to contact the County and report the property lines of the land purchased August of 2021, Tax Parcel Number: 8-1701-00-00-0001 (Ptn SE4 NW4 S 35, T 19, R 41) He is getting bill for the whole 14-acre parcel. Mayor and Clerk will contact Town Attorney for review.

Public Works discussed the well pump that was failing from the previous meeting. The pump is no longer working. Well #1 and Well # 2 run together and so both are not in operation. The Town is operating on two less wells. Public works was able to obtain 2 bids, Halme Electric & Pump with a quote of \$26,421.78, with parts in stock and KME Specialties, LLC quote of \$33,085 which had extra parts/labor not needed. With changes, the quote is \$26,160, and parts were not in stock for 3-6 weeks. Due to the emergent need of the repair, a motion to expedite and declare an emergency relating to the replacement/repair of Well #1 pump was made by Smith and seconded by Bezdicek. Due to parts not in stock and emergent nature of the repair the bid from Halme was approved, all by Resolution #441X.

Liquor License renewal for the Rialto Tavern was reviewed. No objection to renewal by motion from Bezdicek, and seconded by Smith.


Special occasion permit for the Booster Club Try-Athlon was reviewed. No objection to renewal by motion from Smith, and second by Bezdicek.

Spring clean-up- Clerk will contact the school for help. Notice in the March billing will be the same as last time.


