
The Clerk presented a building permit application for a house to be built by Brett and Kadee Larson. The Council wants to see a plot map of the location and want to make sure it meets all state and federal regulations for the flood plain.

Discussion was held regarding the overhead lighting in the Denton Building. An estimate for LED lighting is being worked on.

The Clerk reported that the Mayor and herself met with Apollo Solutions to review the measurement and verification results for the first year of the solar project. The project included a 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year in the project. It was suggested that we contact the Department of Commerce and ask to opt out of this expense since we are pleased with the savings. The Clerk will contact them. It was moved by Smick and seconded by Bezdicek.

The Town received a letter from Whitman County Library that reported that funding for capital projects for libraries will be available in 2021. The Council felt that the LED lighting might be a good project for this funding.

Chris Canaday reported that Bill's Tree Service gave an estimate of \$1400.00 to trim two trees along Jennings St. and the Park. It was moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Smith to ok this project.
