MEETING OF NOVEMBER 28, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hamshar, Hinds, and Smith, community member Mike Thomas, and the town clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the November 14, 2022 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Mike Thomas asked permission to close off more of Front street as he has had additional interest in the June Car Show and expects over 100 cars. An alternate route will need to be set up for the Detour. This will be finalized at a later date. He is looking into outdoor speakers to improve the announcements. They would be mounted on the light poles the night before and taken down immediately after the show. He is also hoping to set up a "vendor row" including fundraising for the local 4-H, swim team, school groups, etc. Approval for the additional road closure, mounted speakers, and vendors was given with a motion from Hinds and seconded by Bezdicek.

The clerk reported that the Whitman Co. Department of Public Works has gone on a first come first serve basis for chip seal and road work. Because of a lack of staff, they will only be able to accommodate 2 towns per district per year. For the year 2023, the slots for District #2 are already filled. The town will need to make contact after the first of the year for the 2024 schedule.

The clerk passed out the proposed cost allocation plan for review. There are no changes in allocations for 2023. The plan was approved by a motion from Hinds and seconded by Smith.

Resident at 201 E Front is having septic issues and inquired about hooking up to Town Sewer. The closes sewer hook-up is across the state high Way and may be cost-prohibitive.


The Council would like to make sure that because the property is close to a well that all setbacks and locations are approved prior to installation.

The Winterfest Celebration will take place on December 3 & 4. A portion of the road will need to be detoured for the official lighting of the Tree. Council agreed this wouldn't be a problem. Resident Edna Fitzgerald has offered a tree for the lighting and the mayor and clerk will contact organizers with the option.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
