



TOWN OF St. JOHN
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MEETING OF JANUARY 22, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicsek, Hinds, Smick, and Smith, Public Works Steve Gibson, and the Town clerk attended the meeting.

The minutes of the January 8th meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smith and seconded by Bezdicsek—a motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Resolution 474X Building Permit Fees was approved and signed.

Public Works gave a cost breakdown on the containment blocks. After discussion, it was approved by Smick and seconded by Hinds to purchase enough blocks to build the containment and delivery by Brandon Miller.

Public works will get a list of remaining manholes and their priority for replacement to the council. A plan is in the works and will be presented to the council at the next meeting.

The plant inflow is higher due to the rain and melting snow. Public works is prepared for possible trouble. There is significant drainage from the field above the solar panels. Some sort of containment will need to be addressed.

Discussion on a surplus sale of the Nissan and Ford ensued. When the weather is better and Public Works has a chance to find a replacement vehicle, a surplus sale will be initiated.

The Clerk brought up future council meetings scheduled for May 27 and November 11. These dates fall on Memorial Day and Veteran's Day. These meetings will be moved to the Tuesday after. The Clerk will Post Changes on the StJohnWA.com.

Vacation days for the clerk were also discussed. The council approved for previous Clerk Linda Hays to fill in June 14-24 and manage the council meeting.

The shop roof repairs were discussed and a permit will be obtained. The roof will be metal interlocking sheets. Billing will be through IEMC. After discussion, the council agreed to pay an admin fee to IEMC for the ability to order supplies through their account.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM.
