Sam Snead and Matt Morkert gave update on the Wastewater Treatment Plant. A major concern is still the I & I issue with the school, manholes, and sump pumps. Follow up with the school will be done by the Mayor. A letter will need to be drafted for those with sump pumps to get them off of the collection system. The department of wildlife is ok with the plan for the new outflow and no other study is needed. They are working on a new dichlorination system. This will consist of 2 samplers that take samples throughout the day.

Spring Clean-Up is set for April 8 & 9 and will have a memo go out in the next bill along with flyers around town.


The Utility Lien for 204 E Oak will be filed on March 14th.
