
The Clerk presented the 2021 Preliminary Budget to the Council. After discussion and review, it was moved by Hinds and seconded by Smick to approve it. It was decided to hold the public hearing for the 2021 Budget on November 9, 2020.

The Clerk reported that the funding came through for the Whitman County Consortium Grant that was given by Dept. of Commerce. The funds will be available at the Community Action Center for our residents sometime between Thanksgiving and Christmas. St. John will receive \$6579.00 to be made available to those who qualify.

Discussion was held regarding the RV trailers that are appearing on lots around town.

Jeff Smick reported on what he found regarding getting a dumpster for residents to put old appliances, solid wastes, etc. He will continue to do some digging to see what we could do. After more discussion, it was decided that we needed to create a new fund for Solid Waste on our 2021 budget.
