
Steve Nelsen gave a report on what would need to be done if we decided to work on our storm sewer infrastructure. We would need to do a sewer plan. We are trying to get a count on how many sump pumps we presently have. The cheapest way for us is to have a chapter in our facility plan that our engineer is presently working on addressing how many and the locations of the sump pumps.


The Clerk reported that USDA have very low interest rates. This would possibly help with future projects.

After more discussion on the Cares Act and the funding the Town could receive, the Council decided that we would not pursue the Funding. There are many stipulations and the possible federal audit that could take place. It was moved by Smick and second by Hinds to reject this funding.

Mike gave a report on the Street Project.

Chris Canaday reported that the pumps in the plant need to be replaced. He will get some estimates and bring back to the Council. He also reported that a toilet needs to be replace in the restroom at the Park. Discussion has been held previously regarding the purchase of a sander for the dump truck for winter use.
