
The Clerk presented the 6-Yr. Transportation Improvement Plan for the Council's review. It was moved by Watson and seconded by Bezdicek to hold the Public Hearing on Aug. 26, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

A building permit was presented by Brett and Kadee Larson to build a family residence. After review of the plans and approval by the building inspector, a motion was made by Watson and seconded by Hinds to approve the permit.

The Clerk reported that the City had received a rebate of \$799.50 from Avista for installing LED lighting in the Denton Building.

Discussion was again held regarding the ditch that runs along Front Street and the Lancaster Road. Jim Thompson gave his recommendation on how to fix the problem so the water drains. He has found enough pipe for the job. It will take approx. 360' of 30" pipe plus clamps. This job will probably cost between \$15,000 - \$20,000.00. Since this is a health issue because of the standing stagnant water almost year-round, the Council voted to fix this problem as soon as possible. It was moved by Smith and seconded by Watson.

Chris Canaday reported on the on-going problem with the sewer plant. It has been decided that the solids pump should be replaced. He has found a dealer that can come down and pull the pump and install a new one for approx. \$5500.00. Repairs to the old one is cost prohibitive. It was moved by Watson and seconded by Hinds to purchase a new pump.
