The Clerk reported that Laura Jones will fill in for her on Mondays and Thursdays from 8 – 12 noon.


The Clerk also reported that the Bid Opening for the Street Project will be Thursday, June 25 at 2:00 p.m.

Discussion was held on the special levy for 2021. After discussion, it was decided to keep the levy for street improvements at \$50,000.00 and eliminate the levy for water and sewer. A motion was made by Smick and seconded by Bezdicek. This motion also was to increase the tax levy for property taxes and new construction by the allowed 1%. All were in favor to adopt Resolution No. 423X.

Chris Canaday reported that the city lawn mower is worn out and needs to be replaced. Dennis Hinds will be looking into options and report back. Chris also asked if they could use the money we received from the scrap that was hauled off to buy an electric air compressor. It was moved by Smith and seconded by Smick.

It was also reported that Tamara Weeks has a huge water leak between her meter and her house. So far, the cause and area has not been discovered. It is felt that a new service line should be installed.

Discussion was also held regarding upkeep properties around town. There are health and safety concerns. Jeff Smick is researching on where we stand and whether or not we have the right to ask them to clean things up. Letters will be written to start off with.
