Council looked over building plans for Thomas and Tiffani Organ. No variances or special permissions are being requested. Motion to grant building permit by Smick and Seconded by Watson.


Public Works Steven Engles reported on the progress of the Nob Hill manhole cover project and the Front Street ditch project. Discussion on buying forks for the backhoe/loader was initiated. Public Works will research prices and availability.

Clerk initiated discussion on possible write off of amount owing on an account from May 2019. Communication sent to residents forwarding address is not getting any response back. Approval to write off \$180 was given with a motion by Smith seconded by Watson.

Discussion about a town trash clean-up day was revisited. Council was in agreement to coordinate with Whitman County Fall Clean Up to take advantage of discount pricing on trash/recycle bins. Clerk will research how other towns manage clean up days. Mayor will write insert for water/sewer billing to bring attention to cleaning up personal property.

Bezdicek researched new LED lighting for the Veterans Tree. Motion to purchase new light by Hinds and seconded by Smith.

Clerk initiated discussion on new computer for City Hall. Quote from Palouse Hills Computing for new computer with higher Ram and bigger processor for \$940 was approved with a motion from Hinds and second by Smick.
