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The Clerk reported that after changing out the street lights to LED, the City is saving \$388.39 a month.

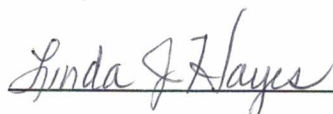

Travis reported that the big sump pump at the sewer plant is down. They were advised to contact a pump company to check it out.

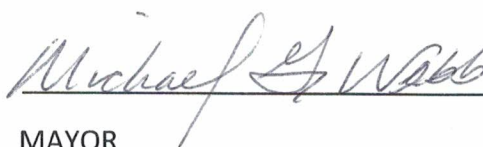
Discussion was held regarding paying our janitor. The Clerk has been running her hours through payroll. Since this is a service, it was felt that she can be paid through claims.
