

MEETING OF MAY 24, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Council Members: Bezdicek, Hinds, Smick, and Watson, Public Works Chris Canaday, community member Dan Wardwell and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the May 10, 2021 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Watson and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

Resident Dan Wardwell asked about adding a cistern under the new proposed deck. Council recommended he additional research before proceeding.

Council looked over building plans for David and Deb Fitzgerald. No variances or special permissions are being requested. Building inspector has reviewed the property. New water meter and sewer connection will be placed at the front property line by the city and property owner will be responsible for lines back to the home. Motion to grant building permit by Bezdicek and Seconded by Hinds.

New owners of 3 S Park sent email requesting approval for a building permit. Council agreed they must contact the Town's Building inspector prior to any approval.

Address for the new residence of Thomas and Tiffany Organ was discussed and agreed to be 201 S East Street. No motion needed.

Estimates to black top, crack, and chip seal Wilson Lane and Bell Lane were reviewed. Motion to approve repairs by Bezdicek and seconded by Smick.

Second water, Grade and roll for Gun Club Rd and Alley previously done by the county approve by a motion from Smick and seconded by Hinds.

Temporary hook up for travel trailer to water and sewer for 108 E State street granted by a motion from Watson and seconded by Hinds with the provision of a time limit. Said time

limit is for 1 year only. Starting July 1, 2021 and above-mentioned travel trailer must be removed on or before July 1, 2022.


Public Works Chris Canaday reported on the progress of the Front Street ditch project. Construction will begin Monday June 21, 2021. Forks for the backhoe/loader were located for \$300 plus shipping. Public Works will verify shipping. If price is \$450 or less approval is granted with a motion by Watson and seconded by Hinds.

Clerk initiated discussion on online class for SAO's BARS overview. City Hall will be closed from 9 AM to 4 PM on June 24th 2021 for the class. The \$100 cost of the class to be paid by the town was approved with a motion from Watson and seconded by Smick.

Public complaint about dogs was discussed. Conclusion that this is a neighbor-to-neighbor issue. Clerk reported she told the resident to write down the incident so the town had documentation.
