

MEETING OF JULY 12, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Council Members: Bezdicek, Smick, and Smith, Public Works Steven Engles, community member Dan Wardwell, and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the Jun 28, 2021 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smith and seconded by Bezdicek. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

Mayor had a discussion with Mr. Isaacs (410 S Loomis) on July, 1, 2021 about moving the disabled van off of the City Right-of-Way. Mr. Issacs agreed to move it out back on his property. Van has not been moved to date.

It was brought to the council's attention there are three (3) trailers parked by the Town drying beds. This is not a storage facility and Mayor Webb will contact owners to move.

Discussion on reviewing past and/or unapplicable ordinances and code enforcement officer was initiated. It was agreed to revisit the topics with all councilmembers present. Mayor Webb will contact a couple other contacts for code enforcement as will Smith.

Discussion on speeding traffic by the park was initiated. Motion by Smith seconded by Bezdicek to purchase four (4) Slow Children at play signs to be placed and anchored by the corners of the park.

Discussion on renewing Town Levy was initiated and agreed by council. Clerk will prepare paperwork for next meeting.

After hours phone was discussed and Clerk will go to or talk with cell phone carriers for service and report back to the council.

Portable bathrooms were discussed for the August show and shine. Subject will be revisited closer to race.

Discussion on opening an interest-bearing account for American Rescue Plan money was initiated. Motion to open such account by Bezdicek seconded by Smick.

Letter from concerned citizen about a dog incident was read and filed for Town records.

Clerk asked to attend Webinars on Aug 3rd from 11 AM-12 PM, Aug 19th 9 AM to 4:30 & Aug 20th 8:30 AM to Noon and the office will be closed during these times. Total cost of \$85 will be paid by the Town. Motion by Smick and seconded by smith.

Public works Steven Engles reported on the ditch jetting. Discussion on well #5 probe for static water level. Public Works is waiting for estimate to purchase and install, will report back for next meeting.

No request for additional comments were stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.
