The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Watson and seconded by Hinds. Motion carried by vote of the Council.



Kim Prisock, from the Dept. of Ecology, discussed with the Council about the problems and errors with samplings starting from 2016. The chain of command was not carried through at times. They reported on what the Town will need to do as far as water tests, temperature data from the effluent and receiving water, and plus some additional monitoring. The Facility Plan that was due at the end of May 2019 has been pushed back a couple of years.

The Clerk reported that the chip sealing that we had asked the County to do might not happen this summer. But there may be a possibility that it could.

The Clerk also reminded Dennis Hinds, Lydia Smith, and Mike Webb that filing for Council positions needs to be done the week of May 13 – 17, 2019.

Chris Canaday gave a report on crack sealing some streets around town. The rental fee for the equipment and the materials needed is almost the same price as what Arrow Concrete & Asphalt Specialties would do the job for. After discussion, the Council decided to hire Arrow Concrete by motion from Watson and second by Smick.
