The Clerk read an email from our engineer regarding sump pumps in town. We need a count and location of where they are at. He suggested that we send out a survey so we can determine this figure. This information would be very useful for the Wastewater Facilities Plan. It was decided that an insert will be sent with the next water bill.

Chris reported on the blue pickup repairs that are needed. He will take it to Highway 23 Auto Repair to see if he can fix it.

The Clerk has been working on finding out information regarding the Coronavirus Funding that is available to all cities through the Wash. State Dept. of Commerce. Frank Watson offered to look over the material.
