**MEETING OF NOVEMBER 27, 2023**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Hamshar, Smick and Smith, Public Works Steven Engles, and the Town clerk attended the meeting.

The minutes of the November 13, 2023 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smith and seconded by Smick—a motion carried by a vote of the Council.

The Clerk gave an update on the elections. Proposition 1 passed with 69.43%, Prop 2 passed with 71.18% and each council member elected with a min of 98.98%.

The clerk discussed the cost of the manhole repair and replacement project. It was requested to transfer funds from the SLFRF/ARPA account to the Street, Sewer, and Storm Drainage accounts. \$22, 541 to the Street fund, \$2,458 to Storm Drainage, and \$25,000 to the Sewer fund. The transfer of funds was approved by a motion from Smick and seconded by Smith.

Public Works gave an update on the progress of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Century West will be coming down to survey the existing plant. Discussion on the deconstruction/decommission of the plant was the main focus.

The Fire Chief (Steven Engles) extended an invitation to the council to the annual Fireman Christmas Party.

Discussion of the Solar Plant ensued. The Clerk will look for the contract to see when the credits will come to an end. A service call may be needed to survey the effectiveness.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:04 PM.
