

MEETING OF JUNE 28, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Council Members: Bezdicek, Hinds, Smick, and Smith, Public Works Steven Engles, community member Dan Wardwell, Heather Larson, Maribeth Kjack and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the Jun 14, 2021 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smick and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

The town has records on the tear down of the old Cold Storage Market but due to the fact records of that nature were not required at the time, no other records about the removal of old tanks from an old service station were kept. Approval to let her know there are no records motioned by Smith and seconded by Smick.

Reminder for no fireworks in city limits will be placed on channel 8 and a reminder has been placed on the water sewer bill.

Public works Steven Engles proposed to have the ditch jetted for clean out at the Community Building. Motion by Hinds and seconded by Bezdicek to have the work done.
