Dan LeBeau introduced himself and announced that he is running for the Whitman Co. District Court Judge in the August Primary.


Larry Harrison discussed the possibility of running a new water line to his property off of Railroad Ave. He has potential buyers and they need water to hook up to while a home is put in. They would like to pull in an RV temporarily while the work is being done. This line will need to be run under the railroad tracks. Bob Westby with DOT will be contacted to see what we can do. Also, the City will check to see if it is possible to hook into sewer.

Lori Loomis discussed with the Council about the on-going issue they have when it rains. The water coming down from the reservoir travels across Brights Street and comes to their door. Over the years attempts have been made but nothing has fixed the problem. Everyone agreed that a solution needs to be reached. The City Engineer will be contacted to get some ideas on what can be done.


The Clerk reported that the past due balance on 417 S. Loomis has been paid. The owners want to keep the water turned off. They are contacting an appraiser and have decided to sell the home.

The Clerk also reported that the Town has received funding of \$131,000.00 from Department of Ecology to be used for the Wastewater Facilities Plan which is due in 2019.
