



TOWN OF St. JOHN
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MEETING OF JUNE 10, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Smick, and Smith, and the Town clerk attended the meeting.

The May 28, 2024 meeting minutes were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smick and seconded by Hinds—a motion carried by a vote of the Council.

The Generator was discussed. There is an estimate to do the rewiring to adapt the generator to the Well. The council would like to see other bids. Due to the time restraints, other quotes may not be feasible.

The jetting of Willson Rd. was discussed. The town used almost an hour of AAA’s time that was billed for the mobilization. The council agreed to let Public Works decide how much the Town would pay towards the bill and how much would be billed to the homeowner.

The sump Pump survey was discussed with the council. The Town will send out the surveys as early as possible with a self-addressed stamped envelope for the homeowner's convenience. The surveys have a return date of July 22, 2024. When the surveys are returned they will be reviewed. If the homeowner needs Public Works to assist in locating and identifying where the pump discharges they will be available.

Accessory Dwelling Units aka Tiny Home was discussed. It was decided a temporary moratorium was needed to gather more information to construct an ordinance. A notice of moratorium was approved with a motion from Smick and seconded by Bezdicek.

The vacating council position was discussed. With only two names the council agreed to conduct interviews on July 22, 2024. The interested parties will be notified.


The supply of culverts were discussed as there was a request to purchase one. The council agreed to let Public Works decide if the Town should keep them in its inventory or sell them.

The Clerk reminded the council that she was going on vacation and Linda Hayes would be filling in a couple of days to get messages, make a deposit, and be the Clerk for the next council meeting.

No request for additional comments was stated. It was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM.
