The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Hinds. Motion carried by vote of the Council.



Chris presented two quotes for pumping out the digester at the sewer plant. One quote from Big Sky - \$3912.50/day and the other from AAA Sweeping - \$5202.50/day. He reported that AAA Sweeping acted like they were not very experienced with this type of project. The Council decided to go with the cheapest quote from Big Sky. It was moved by Hinds and seconded by Smick.

Chris also asked the Council if he could install a gate valve by the creek which, working properly, would keep the creek water from coming into the plant during high water. They felt this would be a good idea. He also reported that Steven will be taking the pesticide class coming up.
