MEETING OF OCTOBER 9, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hamshar, and Smith, Public Works Steve Gibson, community member Judy Hergert, League of Woman Voters of Pullman Mary Collins and Sue Henz, and the Town clerk attended the meeting.

The minutes of the September 25, 2023 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Smith and seconded by Hamshar. Motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Mary and Sue from the League of Woman Voters presented Lydia Smith and the Council with a certificate honoring past women on the council.

Judy Hergert requested the council or mayor have a meeting with the individuals at 7 E Nob Hill about their dog's non-stop barking. The mayor discussed the plan to send out letters the next week. Judy also discussed concerns with the residents at 102 E Nob Hill and the number of animals they have on the property and would like a follow-up on the possibility of puppies on the premises. The clerk will draft letters for mailing.

The clerk shared a quote for the two composite samplers for the wastewater treatment plant. These samplers can be used in the new plant and purchased through the treatment plant budget. After discussion, it was moved by Smith and seconded by Bezdicek to purchase the samplers to get accurate readings for the reports as long as they could also be used in the new plant.

New Hydrants were also discussed. After review and discussion, it was moved by Bezdicek and seconded by Smith to replace the deteriorating hydrants on an as-needed basis, not exceeding 60K including installation. Funding will be a combination of State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds and the town's budget.

No request for additional comments was stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:18 PM.
