

MEETING OF NOVEMBER 23, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Council Members Hinds, Smith, and Watson were in attendance. Also attending were Shani Hergert, Dave Jepsen and Treyton Moore of Anderson Perry & Associates.

The minutes of the November 9, 2020 Meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Watson and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

Dave Jepsen and Treyton Moore, engineers with Anderson Perry & Assoc. gave a presentation of possible wastewater treatment plant designs and options. Costs and alternatives were also reported. This all will be included in the Facilities Plan which is due December 31, 2020. Sump Pump Redirection was also discussed.


Mayor Webb reported that Avista will renew their lease with the Town to store poles. They will pay the Town \$300.00 a month for this service.

The Clerk presented a pay request and change order from the street project just completed by Capstone Structures. The Council approved the request with a motion from Watson and second by Hinds contingent on the Mayors discussion with Anderson Perry.

An estimate was received by Capstone Structures to repair the Front Street drainage issue. After discussion, it was decided that we would postpone the job until reviewing more options.

The Clerk reported on another Business Relief Program through the County. She will distribute the information to several businesses who would be eligible.
