



TOWN OF St. JOHN
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MEETING OF JULY 22, 2024

Mayor Webb called the meeting to order. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hamshar, Hinds, and Smick, Public Works Steven Engles, Steve Gibson, community member Kye Ericksen, and the Town clerk attended the meeting.

The July 8, 2024 meeting minutes were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Hinds and seconded by Smick—a motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Devon Eriksen engaged in a discussion on a possible contract with the town or incorporating the town and the district fire. More discussion is needed.

Discussion on Tax, water/sewer, and street levy. After discussion, it was approved with a motion from Bezdicek and seconded by Smick to renew the current water/sewer (60K total, 30K each) and street levy (80K), along with the 1% tax levy.

The new home discussion for ST JOHN 2ND ADD LOTS 16 & 17, and the use of the road will be determined after the conversation with the Department of Health.

Discussion on 201 W Broadway fallen garage. The owner would now like to rebuild instead of tear down. The council agreed that a structural engineer would need to be involved. Without confirmation that it is structurally sound, the town will not issue a building permit.

Public Works gave an update on the pad for the generator. It has been poured and now will have 21 days to cure prior to getting the generator.

The council will review their notes on the interviews for the open council position and a vote will be issued at a later date.

No request for additional comments was stated. It was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 8:21 PM.
