



TOWN OF St. JOHN
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MEETING OF December 13, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hinds, Smick, Watson, councilmember elect Ed Hamshire, Public Works Steven Engles, community members Dan Wardwell, and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the November 22, 2021 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Watson and seconded by Smith. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

Councilmember Frank Watson was recognized for his many years of service. December 13 is his last official council meeting.

Public Hearing for 2021 Budget amendment was held. Due to higher costs of Waste Disposal and taxes combined with lower revenue from tax collections Fund 410 – Waste Disposal has higher expenditures than budgeted. A motion by Watson seconded by Smick to adopt Ordinance 439X to increase expenditures to the Waste Disposal Fund from \$6,050 to \$9,200.

Clerk initiated conversation to update the council about the Springbrook software upgrade. Now have full cloud storage and security. Payroll will be done for January payroll to co-inside with the start of the new quarter.

Final 2018-2020 Audit conference was held on Dec 8, 2021. Only issue was of the lowest level of concern. Recommendations on procurement for future purchases.

Mayor Webb reported on two light poles that will be needed for Sohon Ct. Motion by Watson seconded by Bezdicek to have light poles installed.

Denny Hinds gave information on building permit that would be needed for metal structure with tie downs, no foundation, electricity, etc. motion to approve by Watson second by Smick provided setbacks are met and building inspector approves.


Council read letters from concerned citizen about noise, trash in yards, roosters. Mayor addressed each concern with the council. Meeting has been requested for one neighbor, the other is aware and working on the trash and junk in the yard. He his hoping to get it cleaned up this winter and spring.

Mayor addressed the concern for the travel trailer parked on city property by golf course. Resident is aware and working on the situation. Should be out by end of the month. If this does not happen there will be a letter sent to vacate and a bill will be given.


Public works gave update on finishing of the ditch project and still working on looking for vehicles. This is not a buyer's market.
