BURIAL POLICY

A resolution of the Whitman County Cemetery District #3, making an addition to the policy for burials.


WHEREAS the Commissioners of the Whitman County Cemetery District #3, Washington, previously adopted a policy on 17 Nov. 2020 for burials at the Cemetery, and

BE IT HERBY RESOLVED, that the Whitman County Cemetery District #3 make an addition (#7) to the previous policy:


1. Burial plots are \$300 each, one plot may include:
 - one casket vault,
 - two cremations with or without an urn vault,
 - one casket vault and one urn without a vault,
2. Vaults are required for all casket burials, urn burials have the option to be with or without a vault,
3. Cemetery Representative will mark the grave site ahead of time for excavation by professional which will be set up with Funeral Director, or the Cemetery Representative will prepare urn burial site for a fee of \$150 for a 3 ft. urn vault opening or a fee of \$100 for 30 in. urn opening without a vault,
4. Cemetery District does not allow families to dig the grave site due to insurance liability,
5. Cemetery District's opening/closing fee of \$50 will be charged on all burials,
6. Cemetery District will have a Cemetery Representative present at all burials,
7. Composted remains will only be accepted in a suitable container, not to exceed 5 gallons in capacity and will be buried as an urn vault.

This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon adoption.


