

## MEETING OF JUNE 14, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. Council Members: Bezdicek, Hinds, Smick, and Smith, Public Works Chris Canaday, community member Dan Wardwell, Heather Larson, Judy Hergert and the Town Clerk were in attendance.

The minutes of the May 24, 2021 meeting were read and approved as read.

Resident Heather Larson expressed concerns for the safety of her dogs and family from the dogs at 301 W Front. Heather has video of one interaction between the dogs and owners. Heather stated the three dogs are not leashed and able to leave their yard whenever outside without supervision. Mayor Webb advised Heather to provide documentation or video to the town. Mayor Webb will send a letter addressing the concerns and possible in person contact.

Resident Judy Hergert expressed concerns for the safety of her family from the dog at 303 S Main and the howling/barking from the dog at 112 E Nob Hill. Judy stated both dogs are out of their yards unsupervised. Mayor Webb will send a letter addressing the concerns and possible in person contact. Judy asked for copies of the letters to be sent to her as well. Mayor Webb confirmed there would be copies in the office as reference and review, but copies would not be mailed to her.

Discussion on paying a portion of the Fire Departments turn out gear per the contract with the Town of St John was initiated. Check was approved by the council. No motion needed per the contract.



Discussion on Tiny homes was initiated. More research is needed and topic will need to be revisited.


Concern for empty lot as fire hazard at 403 S Main by a neighbor was brought to City Hall. Mayor will contact owner.
