

MEETING OF MAY 11, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Mayor, Mike Webb. Council Members Bezdicek, Hinds, Smick, and Watson were in attendance. Also attending was Chris Canaday.

The minutes of the April 27, 2020 Meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion followed. The payables were moved by Watson and seconded by Bezdicek. Motion carried by vote of the Council.

The Clerk reported on the roof inspection of the Denton Building. The roof itself is fine. The white coating is flaking a little. After discussion, it was felt that we need to have it recoated and maintained.

Discussion was held regarding the new sewer line installed at Tom Shawgo's. Part of the line collapsed so a new line was installed. He asked if the City would pay the cost from the main line to his property line. After more discussion, it was decided that the City would be responsible to pay what he requested.

The Clerk asked for authorization to transfer monies from the checking account to the following savings accounts:

- Current Fund - \$50,000.00
- Criminal Justice Fund - \$50,000.00
- Water Fund - \$200,000.00
- Sewer Fund - \$200,000.00


A motion was made by Bezdicek and seconded by Hinds to authorize the transfers.


It was reported that the City Attorney and Gerry Jessen have talked and worked out what needs to be done to change his boundary line adjustment.

It was reported that Larry Harrison is no longer sealing and repairing roofs like what is needed at the reservoir. He referred us to another company that he thought would be able to help us.

It was also reported that Mike, Steven, and the County inspected several roads in town that need some work. We will get the dimensions and submit them to the County. Chip sealing should start sometime in June.

David White visited with the Mayor regarding proper setbacks and hooking up to sewer on a new piece of property he has purchased in town.
