Discussion was held about the possibility of appointing an enforcement officer for the Town. The Clerk will check with Municipal Research to see if a council member can step in. There are several properties in town that we need to address.

A report was given on the work that has been done on the road to the reservoir and the issue of rain run off down the hill. The county took their grader up and graded the road. Gravel is also being spread on the road. It was decided get a load of gravel once a month until we get good coverage.
