Public works discussed condition of Ensign Rd. With the railroad ballast on the road, it is hard on the equipment and difficult to maintain. Re-evaluation is needed this spring. A new welder is needed immediately. The current welder is held together with duct and electrical tape. It is dangerous to use. There was discussion on new mid-grade welder that would be adequate for the shop. Cost for new welder, helmet and other supplies needed is around \$1,500. Approval to purchase was motioned by Hinds and seconded by Bezdicek.


Discussion about the travel trailer and residents at the sewer plant/golf course ensued. The residents are still there, using the community building as facilities, connected to the golf course power, and water from somewhere despite prior notification they would be vacating the

property. Mayor will contact the Golf Board and discuss plans to get them vacated. Due to liability issues camping on city property is prohibited. A letter and a bill for utility usage will be sent.

No request for additional comments were stated and it was moved by Mayor Webb, seconded, and unanimously agreed to adjourn. The Meeting was adjourned at 7:43 PM.
