MEETING OF MAY 22, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Webb. In attendance were Councilmembers Bezdicek, Hamshar, Hinds, and Smith, along with the Town clerk.

The minutes of the May 8, 2023 meeting were read and approved as read.

The payables were presented to the Council for their review and discussion. The payables were moved by Hinds and seconded by Bezdicek. Motion carried by a vote of the Council.

Discussion of .09 Fund was made. They are still working on the decision and will let recipients know as soon as they decide.

The topic of requiring garbage service for all residents was discussed. Two options were discussed: Waste Connections could set up a contract with the town and the town would facilitate the billing, new setup, removal, etc. The town would then be in charge of collections and all aspects of the service adding to the workload of town staff. The second would be to adopt an ordinance that states that everyone in city limits would be required to have garbage service and if a problem occurred with non-garbage collection the town could take legal action that way. The Council will review further.

Residents will be getting letters to address issues of Pet Limits, Cleaning up property, and Alley Access/Fire Safety.


The resident at 210 S Park received a variance from the neighbor at 206 S Park to put a 6-foot fence on the property line.
