Amanda Webb discussed with the Council regarding the Winterfest activities. With all of the COVID restrictions, there is a lot of confusion if our traditions will be possible.


There has been an inquiry whether the Denton Building can be used for Tai Chi classes. The Mayor will do some checking first.
